DAY LAYOUT – WITH A FIRST LOOK

DETAIL PHOTOS for the girls and the guys, Florals, Dress, Suits, Jewelry, Pre-wedding jitters and excitement among everyone.

A few getting ready photos, candid behind the scenes – Makeup, hair, suits on, ties, shoes, more emotions – Animals, children, father of the bride arriving, Mother of the groom...

First Look Photos Bride/Groom (10 Minutes)

Bride & Groom Couples photos – A few Photos (20 Minutes)

Complete Wedding Party Session (30 Minutes)

Entire Wedding Party leave for ceremony location

Wedding Party & Photographers arrive at the ceremony location – Photographs of the emotions/ excitement, guests arriving, decorations, the venue itself, grandparents, + other details.

Ceremony Starts – Photographers gather all the photos they possible can within the rules of the ceremony location. Some Churches do not allow cameras.

CONGRATULATIONS PHOTOS – Coming out of ceremony location and being greeted by your friends and family for hugs and Congrats.

On Location Photographs – Starting with formal photos – Family Photos

More Bride & Groom – Couples Photographs On location or to a secondary location (***This is also the time of Cocktail Hour is you are having one*)

Get ready to be announced and enter for the beginning of reception/dinner

Dinner/Reception Begins – M.C Introductions, housekeeping etc.
